According to **Tramway General Manager Nancy Nichols**, “Our staff has worked tirelessly the past six days to clean up from the August 8 storm event. All systems have been tested and several tons of rock and sand deposited by the flood have been cleared. We look forward to welcoming our guests back and appreciate their understanding during this closure period.”
