PALM SPRINGS, CA (February 8, 2024) – The **Palm Springs Aerial Tramway** will close from **Monday, February 12** through **Wednesday, February 14** to perform continuing road repairs.

The tentative reopening date is **Thursday, February 15** with the first car up at 10:00 a.m.

This week's storms prevented all permanent repairs from being completed, so additional closure days are now required.

Please note that normal Tramway operations and schedules remain in effect through Sunday, February 11.
