



The Palm Springs Aerial Tramway has the world's largest rotating tram cars which carries visitors from the Valley Station, elevation 2,643 feet, to the Mountain Station located at the 8,516-foot level of Mt. San Jacinto State Park and Wilderness.

FACILITIES: In the Valley Station, there is a gift shop and outside patio. In the Mountain Station, there is a gift shop, Peaks restaurant for fine dining, with its beautiful view of the Coachella Valley, Pines Café for casual dining, cocktail lounge, natural exhibits, State Park visitor's center and documentary films about the Park and the Tram history. There are picnic areas and observation points with telescopes at both stations. V.W. Grubbs View Point, at the southeast corner of the Mountain Station, offers 360- degree views of the desert floor and Wilderness area.

AT THE TOP: Within Mount San Jacinto State Park and Wilderness area are 50+ miles of hiking trails, primitive campgrounds and picnic areas. A permit is required for any hiking or backpacking in the Wilderness. This is obtained, free of charge, from the Long Valley Ranger Station at the top of the Tramway. During the winter months with sufficient snow coverage, the Adventure Center will open for cross-country ski and snowshoe equipment rentals. No reservations, first come first serve.

PARKING: The parking fee for cars and vans is \$15.00 per car/van. The parking fee will be waived for buses and customers with local ID. Please prepare to stop and pay at the security gate.

CHAPERONES: The Tramway requires one adult (age 21+) chaperone for every ten individuals age 16 or younger. Please call the Palm Springs Aerial Tramway for rates: 760 325-1449. One adult (age 21+) chaperone for every three children (ages 3-10) is required to visit our gift shops at any one time. Please advise children that chewing gum is not permitted on the premises.

Please note: All chaperones accompanying those 16 years of age or younger must be 21 years of age or older.
